



Call for Abstracts



The AAPA's Clinical and Scientific Affairs Council (CSAC) is announcing a call for abstracts for its 16th Annual Clinical and Professional Poster Session, to be held during AAPA's 35th Annual PA Conference in Philadelphia, May 26-31, 2007.

The poster session offers the opportunity for all PAs, PA faculty, and PA students to present and discuss their research with colleagues and other conference attendees. PA educators are encouraged to submit abstracts on educational research and curricular innovation. PA students are especially encouraged to submit their research projects and assignments completed for physician assistant education courses. As an added enticement, up to three stipends of \$500 each will be awarded to the most outstanding student researchers.

The Poster Session will feature three categories for presentation: original research, case studies and clinical reports, and posters previously presented at medical or scientific conferences held within the past 12 months. Posters will be presented in three galleries: the Clinical and Professional Gallery, the PA Education Gallery, and the Student Research Gallery.

All abstracts must be submitted by a PA or PA student who is a substantially participating author and current member of AAPA.
