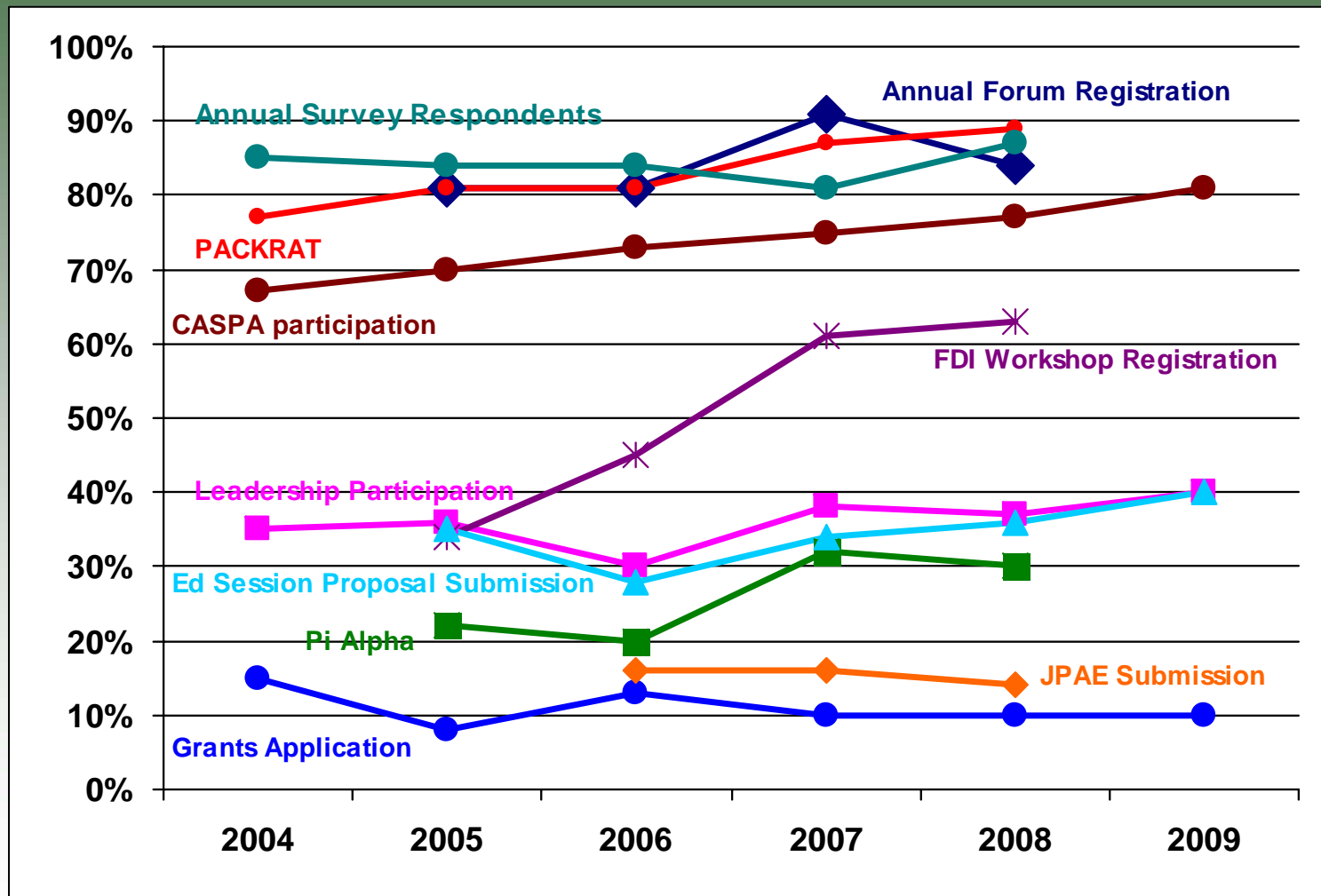
Audit Report

- PAEA's investment losses were .6%, compared to 25-30% nationally
- Administrative costs are 17%; should be under 25%
- Dues are even with last year; down 10% nationally
- PAEA has 15 months revenue in reserve; goal is 12 months
